As I explained in my email reply (9 October 2018) Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga has not agreed to any proposals or plans of Ryman Healthcare in relation to their site at the former Karori Teachers College.

Our organisation has had discussions with representatives of Ryman Healthcare and this includes two meetings that I have personally attended.

From our perspective the discussions remain ongoing. We believe that there are still a number of matters that we have sought clarification on from Ryman Healthcare and we are currently awaiting their advice on dates and times for these discussions to continue.

In my email response I did ask where you received information of our 'agreement' from. It concerns me that this was blatantly wrong and it concerns me that such comments are being attributed to us. I await your response on this.
