1. Thank you for your letter of 30 April 2019.
2. In your letter you responded to our request for information regarding your reference to the HNZ Board's strategy to attain "the best possible heritage outcome for this site." (3 December 2018).
3. Our request asked you: "What is the best possible outcome?" We asked this question in order to better understand what it was that HNZ was aiming to achieve for the site in its discussions with Ryman, WCC and MCH etc.
4. Your letter of 30 April has stated that HNZ is yet to form an opinion regarding what the best possible outcome for the site is.
5. Thank you for confirming that - despite the undertaking various discussions over the last two or so years within the HNZ Board, and with VUW, Ryman, WCC, and (presumably) MCH, in the context of its legislated functions under the HNZ Act - that HNZ is yet to form a view regarding the best possible heritage outcome for the Category 1 Karori Teachers' College site.
6. We remain concerned regarding HNZ's lack of efficacy in achieving protection of the heritage values identified in the HNZ registration report for the Karori campus. The absence of HNZ having formed an opinion as to what the best heritage outcome it is trying to achieve for the site is consistent with our ongoing concerns.
